SITUATIONS AND NORMS

We propose a new theory of internalized social norms. It builds on three premises. A norm is a recommended strategy profile in a socially defined situation. Norms embody broad social values and thus respond to situations in predictable ways. Individuals themselves do not have strong social preferences beyond the desire for norm compliance. We demonstrate that the theory accounts for many experimentally documented violations of social preference models.
