## ***Undergraduate Internships/Training Grants***

microMORPH is an NSF-supported Research Coordination Network that promotes and fosters cross-disciplinary interaction through a series of small grants that allow undergraduates to visit labs and botanical gardens with the aim of gaining laboratory experience while contributing to scientific research on plants

These grants are available to support training visits for a period of a summer (or summer semester equivalent). **We are committed to supporting diverse aspects of plant evolution and development as related to questions or processes of microevolution.**

### **Award Amount**

Each year, microMORPH is able to fund 10-week research internships/training grants for undergraduates. **\$5,000 is available per grant, which can be used for travel and housing for the period of the internship.**

### **Submission Deadline**

The next deadline for microMORPH Undergraduate Internships/Training Grant applications is **11:30 pm, March 15th, 2016.**
