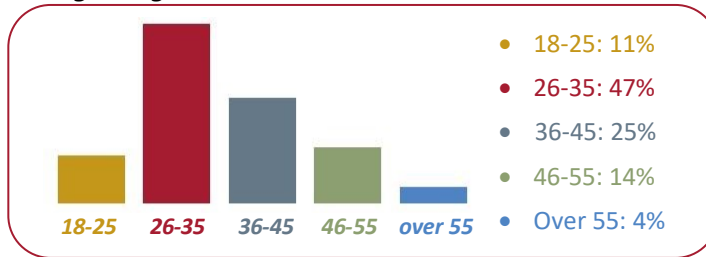

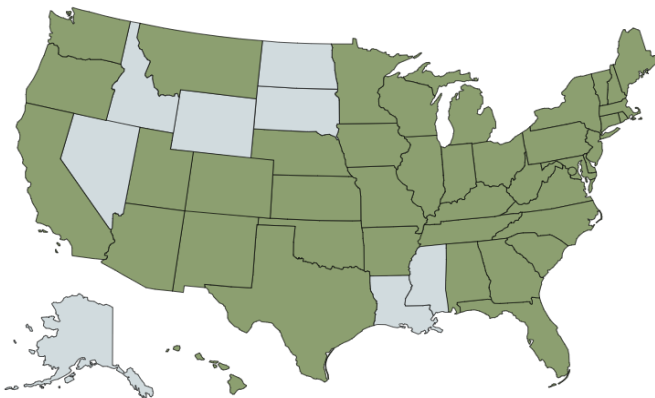

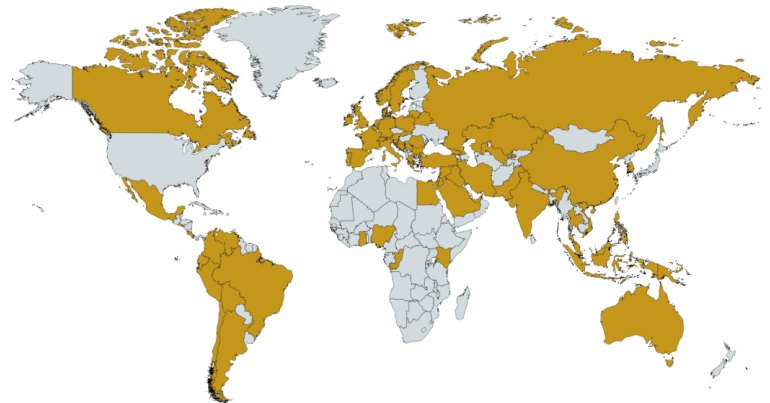

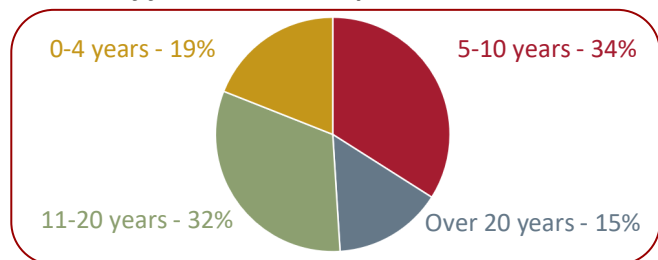

**86%** were employed full-time while pursuing a certificate.

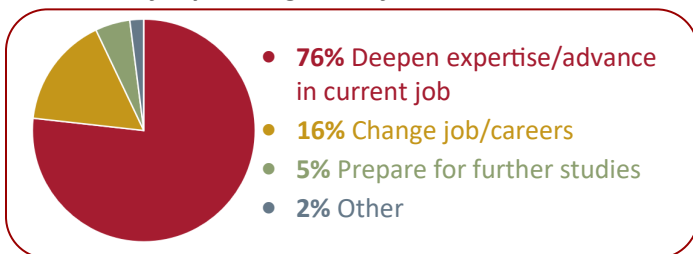
**41%** report that simply completing coursework toward their certificate contributed to career benefits, including:

- Career change

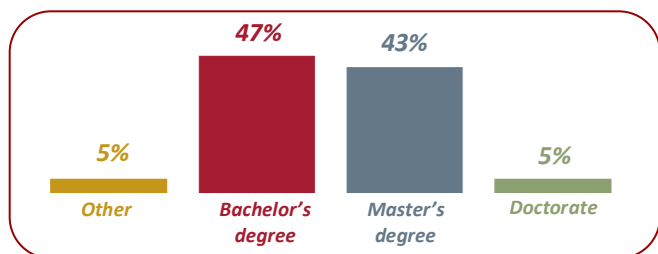
#### Years of full-time work experience

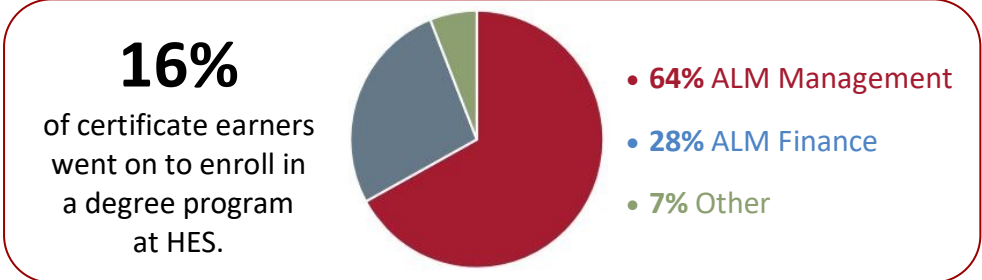
Select job titles held by our certificate earners
